

IRÁNYVONALAK A BESZÁMOLÓ FELADAT MEGÍRÁSÁHOZ

Figyelmesen olvassa el a feladatkírást és adekváтан, megfelelő terjedelemben fejtsse ki az irányító szempontokat.

A beszámoló címébe foglalja bele, hogy konkrétan miről szól a beszámoló.

Az első mondatban fejtsse ki, hogy milyen kérdést fog elemezni a beszámolóban.

A következő négy bekezdésben a négy irányító szempontra koncentráljon. Egy bekezdésben egy szempontot fejtsen ki, megfelelő részletességgel. Ügyeljen arra, hogy a szempontokat objektíven, a tényekre szorítkozva fejtsse ki. Személyes véleménye ebben a részben nem kaphat teret.

Az utolsó bekezdésben egyértelműen foglaljon állást, fejezze ki konkrét javaslatát.

A beszámoló aláírással, a pozíció és a dátum feltüntetésével zárul.

A beszámoló stílusa formális, amely megfelel a jelenlegi üzleti környezet kívánalmainak. Kerülje a rövidítéseket, összevonásokat, informális kifejezéseket.

Ügyeljen arra, hogy a beszámoló műfaja eltér a levélétől, nem szerepel benne megszólítás, nincs benne elköszönés, a beszámolóban nem szólíthatjuk meg azt a személyt, akinek a beszámoló íródott.

A szövegnek logikusan felépítettnek kell lennie, bekezdéseket kell tartalmaznia.

A beszámolóban a vizsgázónak a szinten elvárható szakmai szókinccs és nyelvtani szerkezetek használatával kell megjelenítenie a szakmai tartalmat.

Az angol nyelvű üzleti életben nemcsak egyféleképpen készítenek beszámolót. Az alábbi mintamegoldás csak az egyik lehetséges változat. A vizsgán minden olyan beszámolót elfogadunk, mely valamely, a szakmai életben bevett formát követi.

Report on Themed Tours to Hungary for Those who are Interested in Hungarian Gastronomy

This report, which looks into the question of whether our travel agency should organize gastronomy tours to Hungary, has been requested by Ms Janet Wilkins, the proprietor of Sunshine Travel Agency.

I did some research into Hungarian gastronomy and I have found that Hungarian cuisine loves lard. Moreover, Hungarians use a lot of spices (for example hot paprika) and vegetables. Instead of starters they prefer various types of cold and warm soups. In addition, quality wines can be offered that match the dishes (eg. the Bull's Blood of Eger).

Hungary provides a wide range of catering options, from small local inns to exclusive restaurants, four of which have been awarded the Michelin star. (Costes, Onyx, Tanti and Borkonyha). The well-known Gundel restaurant is a good example of modern Hungarian gastronomy and hospitality.

Gastronomy can easily be combined with city breaks and cultural tourism. Eger is an excellent example where wine, gastronomy, history and culture go hand in hand. Organizing a wine-tour in this area could also be considered.

As a next step, I carried out a survey among our regular customers and they find the idea of themed tours to Hungary interesting and worth trying. It is mainly middle-aged couples living in cities who would participate.

I recommend the organizing of gastronomy tours since only a few of our competitors offer themed tours in this field.
